

## Installing Linux and NetBeans on a Windows Machine



install virtualbox    google virtual box to install on host machine  
install kubuntu    google search for kubuntu - I'm using 14.10 - 32bit on this machine  
- download iso for the flavor you want  
- start virtual box and create a new VM and follow directions - fairly quick  
| - you may need to enter bios and enable virtualization support (dell F2 at Dell logo)  
- you may need to disable Hyper-V (programs and features -> add windows features)  
Set background:    right-click on desktop and select default desktop settings  
Fix resolution:    system settings -> Driver Manager -> select guest service, then restart  
Install gcc:        sudo apt-get build-essential  
install jdk8        type jdk in google search - takes you to download page  
install netbeans:    Go to netbeans.org and download (see directions on Lect #3 page  
install dropbox:    Got to dropbox.com and register or login, then install  
install stickynotes: google sticky notes kubuntu, select "install sticky notes indicator ..."
