1. Finding course pages:

From the home page, use Courses > select course. You find that in the top menu.

- Finding lectures:
  From any course page, click on Lectures, top left, or press the L key.
  From any lecture page, use Lectures > select lecture.
- 3. Finding Project Statements:

From any lecture page, use Projects > Project #N

4. Finding code samples:

From any lecture page, use Directories, and select Repository/Cpp, or Repository/CSharp, or Repository/Tools

- 5. Finding Project Helper Code:From any lecture page, use Directories > cse[crs num] > code > ProjectNHelpS2019
- Finding Visual Studio Help:
  From any lecture page, use Resources > Visual Studio Help
- Finding Clean.bat: From any lecture page, use Projects > CodeAnalExes + Clean.bat
- 8. Finding Submission Requirements:

From any lecture page, use Projects > Submitting Projects

9. Submitting Projects (Finding Upload Links):

From any lecture page, use Projects > Uploading Projects > Course link (use the correct link). For this to succeed, your project must be less than 25 MB, so clean your solution and use clean.bat
